



## Paper Submission Terms and Conditions

By submitting a paper authors agree to the terms and conditions set out below:

1. If the paper is accepted for presentation and/or publication, you agree to give us permission on behalf of all authors, to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the paper (submitted text only), together with author names, and biographies where supplied, in different formats including print, electronic and digital forms (including on the SaltMech homepage).
2. The authors are responsible for the accuracy of the paper and should ensure that they have written entirely original work, which does not infringe on any copyright.
3. The corresponding author should ensure that all appropriate co-authors are included on the paper and that the submission has been approved by all authors.
4. At least one author must be available to present the paper if selected for the conference programme, for either an oral or poster presentation.
5. All authors presenting at the conference must register and pay the registration fee in order to attend the conference as a delegate. If the presenting author is not registered as a conference delegate, the paper will be withdrawn. The authors will immediately notify the SaltMech organizing committee if they are unable to present a paper or if the presenting author is changed.
6. If the author(s) have any commercial interests or associations that might pose a conflict of interest regarding their submission, these must be declared. If a contribution is accepted for presentation, the commercial interest or association must be declared on the title slide (for oral presentations) or at the bottom of the poster (for poster presentations). All poster presentations should include funding and other acknowledgements where applicable.
7. Authors grant permission to the organizers to photograph their oral presentation at the conference, recognizing that this resulting material may be used on the SaltMech website.
8. Papers will be reviewed by a panel of reviewers with the final decision on revision/acceptance/rejection being made by the scientific committee. Evaluation of the paper is done on the basis of the standard of the content presented.
9. Acceptance of a paper does not imply provision of
  - travel, accommodation or registration costs for the conference,
  - any other cost associated with preparation or presentation of the paper,
  - or any cost associated with attendance of the conference.
